

2021 TERMS & CONDITIONS

Be informed and enjoy your vacation. Please read the Terms & Conditions carefully. You may be required to sign a copy indicating your understanding upon arrival.

It is our goal to provide services and products which enable all of our overnight guests to enjoy their vacations in a safe, secure, and memorable environment. These Terms & Conditions are written in everyone's best interest to achieve that goal. During your vacation, we encourage you to take full advantage of our activities/events and amenities. Our most important rule to remember is to HAVE FUN. If there is anything we can do to make your stay more enjoyable, please let us know. *Resort Management reserves the right to revise Rules/Terms & Conditions due to mandates/rules/regulations as set forth by government officials due to COVID-19.

RESERVATION POLICIES

PAYMENT

All reservations, regardless of stay type require a 2 night minimum deposit or 50% (greater of the two) deposit via credit card. For all reservations, the balance must be paid in full upon arrival.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Nightly or Weekly Stays: No refunds on or after arrival. Cancellations made at least 7 days in advance will be refunded in the form in which it was paid. Deposit will be forfeited for all reservations cancelled less than 7 days prior to your arrival date.

Monthly Stays: No refunds on or after arrival. Cancellations made at least 45 days in advance will be refunded in the form in which it was paid. Deposit will be forfeited for all reservations cancelled less than 45 days prior to your arrival date.

Refunds are prohibited for weather condition, voluntary departure, acts of nature, or evictions. Any refund processed will be refunded in the same form that it was originally paid or a reservation credit can be issued towards a future stay to be used within one year from the date the reservation credit was issued. All refunds processed via credit/debit card, will be processed back to the original credit/debit card used, no exceptions.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

Check-out time: 11am

Vacation Rentals

Check-in time: 4pm
Check-out time: 11am

A charge will apply to all late check-outs.

For Vacation Cottage Rentals, keys must be returned to the main office by your designated check-out time in order for your key deposit to be refunded.

ACCOMMODATION & SITE LOCATION

All site numbers are subject to change prior to arrival, unless a site lock fee was paid with your reservation. We reserve the right to change site numbers for all reservations at our discretion without prior notice. No refunds/discounts will be issued due to site number changes.

For tent/RV sites - a maximum of 1 camping unit is permitted per site.

Each site accommodates a maximum of 1 vehicle.

Use of tents or secondary units on vacation cottage rental sites is prohibited.

SECURITY DEPOSIT (VACATION RENTALS)

Upon check-in, a credit card will be required for a \$300 security deposit. This amount will be held as a pre-authorization on your credit card, nothing is charged to the card unless there is damage done to the vacation cottage/site during your stay, or excessive cleaning required upon your departure.

PERMITTED OCCUPANTS

All reservations have a maximum of 6 people including children. Rates are based on 2 adults and 4 children. We

reserve the right to cancel your reservation and the cost of your vacation will be forfeited, should you have more than the permitted number of guests.

We are a family resort and as such we will not accept bookings from individuals under the age of 25. This means if you are not a family travelling with your children, everyone on the reservation must be over the age of 25. We reserve the right to cancel a reservation without refund if this is not met.

GENERAL RULES

QUIET HOURS

11pm to 8am daily

GUESTS

Only registered guests are allowed to use the resort and its amenities. Please have all your guests register at the office. Fees do apply - Adult \$7/day. Children \$7/day. Carload \$20/day (applicable taxes apply).

SAFETY

Children under the age of 18 must wear helmets when riding bikes. Children under the age of 12 should not be left unattended. Anyone under the age of 18 must be on their sites by 11pm unless accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 25.

CAMPFIRES

Firewood must be purchased from the main office. Burning of pressure treated wood is prohibited. Please ensure that your fire is completely extinguished before retiring for the night. As we border 3 different counties, we follow whichever fire ban is most severe.

PETS

There is a maximum of two pets per reservation. NO pets in rental units or pool or beaches/common areas. Only non-aggressive dogs and/or cats are permitted in the resort. Pets are welcome as long as they're on a leash at all times. However, we offer an off-leash Dog Park across from the main office.

Animals cannot be a disturbance to other campers.

Please ensure you clean your site & surrounding area of any pet waste prior to your departure.

GARBAGE/RECYCLING

All garbage/recycling is to be put in the designated areas, garbage bins, and recycling receptacles located on the Resort Map.

LAUNDRY

Washer and dryers (x3) are available in the on-site laundry room. Please do not attach anything to the trees for drying purposes.

SMOKING

For your health and enjoyment of all, all accommodations are non-smoking. A \$300 Smoking Fine will be charged to your credit card if you smoke inside accommodations or facilities. Smoking/vaping/marijuana are allowed on your own sites only and are prohibited in all communal areas

unless designated. Cigarette butts must be disposed of in the designated receptacles.

GOLF CARTS & WATERCRAFT

Golf carts and motorized toys are not permitted. If you require use of your personal golf cart, for health reasons, you must arrange this through the office ahead of time, and terms and conditions will apply. Unlicensed individuals (without full G license), may not operate golf carts in our resort.

Watercraft of any type and their trailers are NOT to be stored on site. Motorized watercraft are NOT allowed in the lake.

FIREWORKS

Fireworks/sparklers are not permitted on property.

POOL & SWIMMING

No lifeguard on duty at the pool or beach. Hours and rules are posted at the pool. First Aid equipment is available at the pool. Our pool and lake are unsupervised, and are 'swim at your own risk'. They are only for use during daylight hours. Our pool is monitored and maintained to meet standards of the Health Department.

PARKING & RESORT ROADS

Each site accommodates a maximum of 1 vehicle. Any additional vehicles must be parked at the Guest Parking at the front gate. Please obey all posted signs and speed limits. Please watch for children and pedestrians at all times. Rules and Regulations under the Highway and Traffic Act apply within the resort.

ALCOHOL & GLASS CONTAINERS

Alcohol is only permitted on your site. Glass and glass bottles must remain on your own sites. Open alcohol is forbidden in all vehicles.

EXCESSIVE WEAR AND TEAR

The person making/paying for vacations are financially responsible for the cost of repairs arising from any damage beyond normal wear and tear including but not limited to carpet/floor stains, interior wall damage, appliance repairs arising from improper use, window and window covering damage, permanent linen stains, dry cleaning costs associated with stains, breakage, theft, and any other damage noted on departure incurred, sustained or brought by any person occupying or using the accommodations.

AMENITIES & FACILITIES

Please remember that all amenities are on a seasonal, weather dependent schedule and may have limited hours during the Spring and Fall. We reserve the right to close any facilities at our discretion without prior notice.

PRIVACY & VACATIONING WITH RESPECT

Please be considerate of your fellow neighbours, privacy, and space. Please do not walk-on, nor pass through other sites. We hope you enjoy our resort, and we ask that you treat with respect at all times. Please respect our local culture, wildlife, and seasonal guests.
